RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE USE OF SCHOOL FACILITIES

- 1. Requests must be made in writing for the school facilities 60 days prior to usage date.
 - a. Three (3) documents constitute an official application for use of school facilities:
 - i. The application
 - ii. The enclosed Agreement properly executed
 - iii. A certificate indicating that the Board of Education is covered by the user's liability insurance in connection with this use of school property.

\$10,000 / \$25,000 Liability Property Damage: \$100,000 / \$300,000 Bodily Injury.

The Linwood Board of Education must be named as additional insured.

- 2. Payment to cover a custodian, hired by and responsible to the Board of Education, in charge of the building to open, to be on hand if needed, and to clean and close down the facility outside of normal working hours.
- 3. A designated list of person (s) responsible for the group that is to be on hand for the activities must be submitted at the time of written request.
- 4. A person is to be designated as "person in charge" of the group who is to be in attendance.
- 5. Shower and locker facilities will not be available.
- 6. No footwear other than appropriate sneakers or gym shoes are to be on the gym floor at any time.
- 7. All equipment is to be provided by the group involved.
- 8. If bleachers are desired, a phone call to the Superintendent's office is necessary by 4:00 PM of the same day.
- 9. Linwood residents will be the only participants in any function dealing with recreational activities unless previously approved by the Superintendent of Schools.
- 10. No food or beverages are permitted in the Gymnasiums or classrooms.
- 11. Positively no smoking in the school building.
- 12. No alcoholic beverages will be brought to or consumed in the buildings or on the grounds.
- 13. Prior permission must be obtained prior to putting up decorations or scenery, or moving pianos or other furniture is not permitted unless special permission is granted from the superintendent.
- 14. The applicant agrees to reimburse the Board of Education or the school promptly for any loss or damage occurring to the building or any equipment during use by the applying organization.
- 15. The applicant is responsible for the preservation of order, including both participants and spectators which also include the evacuation of the building during an emergency.
 - A minimum of one (1) adult chaperone for every ten (10) children attending the activity is required to maintain expected order in the location of the activity and the hallways where needed. Children are not to be left unsupervised at any time.
- 16. The Board of Education or its representatives shall have access to all areas of the building at all times.
- 17. No reservations will be made until the application is approved and written approval is issued to the applicant.
- 18. Fees are to be paid to the Board of Education at least one week in advance of the scheduled use of the requested facility.

- 19. Violation of any of the above conditions may be the cause for depriving the group of the immediate or further use of the school.
- 20. All portable objects must be removed from the Gym prior to its use and repositioned following the activity.
- 21. Outdoor recreation areas are to be kept free of litter. Trash containers are to be emptied after each activity.
- 22. All doors, including gym doors, are not to be propped open, and must be closed at all times.
