2018-2019 Budget Presentation - Mr. Pruitt and Mrs. Weeks reviewed the 2018-2019 budget as revised. The budget represents a .15% increase in the tax levy however, the tax rate increase is \$0.022 due to the decline in the ratable base. The district received additional state aid and is anticipating a significant amount of fund balance to fund this budget. Fiscal responsibility and the impact to the taxpayer were discussed. Concerns moving forward were highlighted including the lack of investment in education over the base several years. The board members commented on the decrease in position due to retirement, inquired about security positions, after school activities, and library media positions. Concerns regarding room in budget for initiatives and other contingencies discussed. Request to consider further decrease to the taxpayers also made.
